WHEREAS, THE DES MOINES POLICE DEPARTMENT, NEIGHBORHOOD GROUPS, BUSINESSES, AND CONCERNED CITIZENS WORK TOGETHER DILIGENTLY THROUGHOUT THE YEAR TO PREVENT CRIME USING SOUND COMMUNITY POLICING STRATEGIES; AND

WHEREAS, NEIGHBORHOOD AWARENESS, SPIRIT, AND COOPERATION ARE IMPORTANT THEMES OF THE "NATIONAL NIGHT OUT" PROJECT AND ARE KEY COMPONENTS IN FIGHTING CRIME AND CRIME PREVENTION; AND
