

Iowa House & Senate Candidate Public Forum

On Tuesday, April 24th from 6:30 to 8:00pm a public forum will be held for candidates for the Iowa Legislature in House District 36 and Senate District 18. The location of the forum will be at the Northwest Community Center, 5110 Franklin Avenue, Des Moines.

The forum is being hosted by representatives from the neighborhoods of Beaverdale, Drake, Waveland Park, Meredith, Merle Hay, and Webster Township. House District 36 and Senate District 18 represent portions of these neighborhoods in the Iowa legislature. All residents are encouraged to attend. The primary on June 5, 2012, will select one candidate from each party for the general election in November. All declared candidates are invited to attend.

A moderator will give each candidate the opportunity to speak and respond to questions from the audience. The candidates for Iowa House that have been invited are Marti Anderson (D), Cara Kennedy-Ode (D), William Rock (D) and Larry Steele (R). The candidate for Iowa Senate that has been invited is Janet Petersen (D). Other candidates who declare prior to the filing deadline will be invited.

Lead Based Paint Program

Lead based paint is still the primary source of lead poisoning in Iowa. Two-thirds of our housing was built before 1978 when lead based paint was banned. Every child deserves a lead-free home. If you are a homeowner or landlord in Polk County you may be eligible for assistance from The Metropolitan Partnership for Lead Safe Housing.
