AACTE data reporting changes

The annual PEDS (professional education data system) report data collection is currently suspended, and will remain suspended (Drake SOE has been submitting this report annually for the past 20 years). AACTE wants become more of a data aggregator instead of a data collector. They are also trying to reduce duplicate data collection efforts. They plan to provide a data

dashboard that AACTE member institutions like Drake can use from AACTE rather than send to AACTE. They also want better benchmarking data (comparable from one institution to another), for instance for graduate and employer satisfaction. They will create a new survey that will be on a voluntary, sampling basis, starting with graduate and employer satisfaction surveys (not all institutions/graduates/employers will be asked to participate each year). By next annual conference (March, 2017), they will have a 1st report available.

Predictive validity of dispositions to student success

#1 dispositional predictor of student success: Preparation for class and appointments. (Other predictors include: (2) maintains professional appearance, (3) demonstrates flexibility during the learning experience (4) responds positively to constructive criticism and (5) demonstrates high expectations for others. Legal cases support institutions in dismissing students who do not meet communicated dispositional expectations.

LiveText update

LiveText is releasing a new platform on April 6, 2016 that has a more social media look to it than the current platform. Drake SOE can tell LiveText when we are ready to migrate to the new platform.

edTPA update

These are the states now using edTPA in their initial teacher preparation programs: In the midwest - Iowa, Minnesota, Illinois, Wisconsin; in the east - New York and New Jersey; in the south - Tennessee and Georgia; in the west - California and Washington.

ESSA

ESSA=The Every Student Succeeds Act (signed into law in December, 2015) changes funding for state Teacher Quality Grant, aka Title II. Iowa currently receives about 17 million dollars and this will hold steady for a couple of years and then fall by about a million dollars by 2020. Other states will lose or gain a lot more (up to 10 million in gains or losses are expected in some states).
