Head Start grant funding renewals

Drake University has received notification that the continuation grants for both the Head Start/Early Head Start and Early Head Start-Child Care Partnership are approved. Drake has held the \$6.8 million Head Start/Early Head Start grant for 39 years providing services 926 low-income, at-risk children and families across six counties. The \$1 million Early Head Start-Child Care Partnership is in its 2nd full year of implementation. The grant funds quality enhancements for seven child care centers in the urban core of Des Moines. Drake University Head Start provides child care centers with quality materials (including curriculum/assessment), minor site alterations, instructional coaching, staff differential, and monitoring using research-based tools. All of the child care centers and Head Start classrooms must meet the strict requirements of Head Start Program Performance Standards.
