Much lower cost for graduate program applications

This is BIG news. The cost and barriers to many of Drake SOE graduate programs are now very, very low. The online application is now FREE for all applicants. Many of the SOE graduate programs have also voted to go test free regarding admissions. The counseling, ABA, and doctoral programs will retain testing, but the faculty voted last month to eliminate the Drake Writing Test for all other Drake graduate programs. The process will be the same for the face-to-face and online programs.

Graduate Commencement highlights

Eleven SOE doctoral students will be hooded at commencement this year, by doctoral chairs Beisser, Cooper, Fairbairn, Gillespie, and Johnson.
