Sally Beisser chosen as a Levitt **Distinguished Professor**

The Ellis and Nelle Levitt Distinguished Professorship has long been an important way to recognize and reward superior performance by Drake University faculty members. Only one new Levitt Professor was selected this year, and it was given to Sally Beisser, Professor of Education. Congratulations, Sally!!

The criteria for selection included teaching effectiveness as demonstrated by teaching in a classroom setting and/or mentoring in an experiential learning setting, professional contributions through scholarly activity, demonstrated leadership, consulting activities, and contributions to the mission of the department, college and university. In addition to the title, Levitt Professors receive a \$5,000 annual supplement to their salary. The initial appointment is for five years. During the fifth year, performance is reviewed to determine whether continuation as a Levitt Professor is merited.

Early Head Start-Child Care Partnership

Drake University Head Start was among the first to receive the Early Head Start - Child Care Partnership grant two years ago. Partnering with seven child care centers in the Urban Core of Des Moines has increased the quality of programming for Early Head Start children (birth to three) in the form of environments, materials, and practices: the workforce knowledge base has grown as has their professionalism through instructional coaching and early childhood classes. Family engagement supports families as they move to self-sufficiency and learn the skills to be their child's most important teacher. As a result of the successful implementation of the grant, Drake University Head Start has been invited by the National Center for Early Head Start-Child Care Partnerships (jointly administered by the Administration for Children and Families' Office of Head Start and Office of Child Care) to present to new EHS-CCP grantees at the "Early Head Start Expansion" and Partnership Planning Meeting". The focus will include fiscal implications, professional development, and family engagement as we discuss "Partnerships in Practice: Lessons from the Field". Monica Garner, an Early Childhood Program Coordinator with Drake University Head Start, and Laura Trainer, Owner/Director of Wonder Years Academy will participate in the presentation and a video about best practices and lessons learned over the past two years.
