FYI: Renewal Credit Change

For educators that hold a specialist's degree (not endorsement or certificate) or a doctor's degree, **two** renewal credits (instead of four) are required to renew a master educator, professional administrator, or professional service license. The professional administrator license renewal still requires the completion of an approved evaluator course. Applicants will need to provide a picture/scan of official transcripts showing the specialist's or doctor's degree earned when they apply to renew.
